We follow the five principles of good peer review: **Content Integrity, Content Ethics, Fairness, Usefulness, and Timeliness.**

The peer review process:

- Step 1: Editor-in Chief assessment, download PDF, judge either to reject article or
- Step 2: First round of peer review. The editor-in Chief, or one of the associate editors will handle article and find and contact other researchers who are experts in your field, asking them to review the paper
- Step 3: Editor-in Chief collects 2-3 referee reports
- Step 4: Authors revise and resubmit
- Step 5: Final referees judgement
- Step 6: Accept or reject article by editor-in Chief.
